ANTICIPATED

Yesterday the Twelfth State Legislature in special session added to the statutes of New Mexico a new and a great governmental responsibility by the enactment of an Unemployment Insurance law. Henceforth the state government will be engaged in one of the widest departures in social security ever undertaken.
