George Stevens Page, retired general manager of the Park Works of Crucible Steel Co., died last night in Shadyside Hospital after an illness of nine days of pneumonia.

Mr. Page, who resided in the Bellefield Dwellings, was born Sept. 21, 1864, in Eagleswood, N. J., a son of William Page, portrait painter, and Sophia Candace Stevens Page.

Mr. Page came to Pittsburgh in 1885.

Mr. Page was a graduate of Columbia University in 1885. He was a member of the Point Breeze Presbyterian Church, the Columbia University Alumni of Pittsburgh, and a life member of the American Society of Mining Engineers.
