

## Prominent Farmer at Spencer, Iowa, Killed

Spencer, Ia.—Special: George Rausch, prominent middleaged Clay county farmer, was killed Tuesday noon when he was either jolted backward or stricken with a heart attack and fell from his tractor into a corn binder. He and his hired man, John Coddington, were working in a field of sorghum corn near the Rausch home, northwest of Spencer. —

Coddington, shocking corn behind the binder, was unable to release Rausch from the carry chains of the binder and had to run for aid of neighbors. Rausch was dead before the binder could be torn apart and his body removed. County Coroner J. M. Sokol pronounced death accidental. The widow and five children survive.
