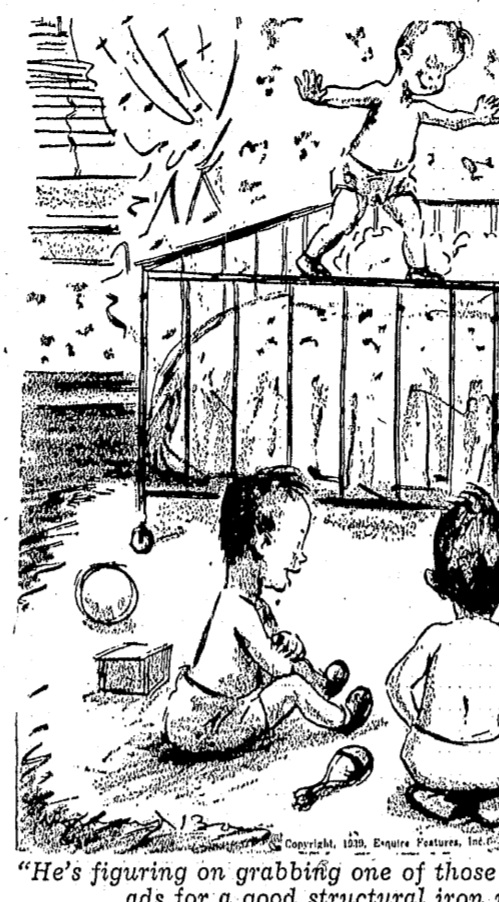

Onie Cook, manager of the Lexington Producers' stockyards, gave the business report for 1938 at the meeting, disclosing that 18,676 cattle, 4,914 calves, 27,014 hogs and 67,882 sheep and lambs were sold by farmers through the co-operative association.
