

DEATH OF MRS. MARY LOCKEY.

Died Yesterday in Helena Aged 86 Years

—Funeral To-morrow at St.

Paul's.

Mrs. Mary Lockey, widow of John Lockey, died yesterday morning at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Emily Bruhn, 703 Eighth avenue. Mrs. Lockey was born June 9, 1813, at Gunnerside, Yorkshire, England, and was married July 2, 1840. The family came to the United States in 1846, locating at Dubuque, Ia., where Mrs. Lockey resided until after the death of her husband, which occurred Feb. 11, 1874. In 1879 she came to Helena joining four of her sons who were then located here. She was the mother of three daughters and seven sons, two daughters and four sons surviving her—Mrs. Jennie Bowman, of Anamosa, Ia.; Bernard Lockey, of Everly, Ia.; Richard and John W. Lockey and Mrs. Sarah E. Bruhn, of Helena, and James T. Lockey, of Winston. Two of her sons, George W. (Will) and Joseph, died in Boseman in 1882. Her only surviving brother, John Haw, resides at Philbrook, Mont.

The funeral services will be held at St. Paul's Methodist Episcopal church at 2:30 p. m. to-morrow, Rev. Mr. Van Ordel and Rev. E. M. Dugger officiating, when the body will be temporarily buried in the Masonic cemetery, it being the intention to remove it for final interment to the old home at Dubuque.
